



Internship: User Experience Designer

THE JOB

As a User Experience intern, you will be part of a skilled team consisting of project managers, IT-architects, software developers, visual UI designers and qualified user experience designers. During the internship, you will be involved in all stages of the development process from initial design meetings with customers to test of the total design concept. During this process, you will be a valuable link between our users and customers on one side, and our team of developers on the other, as you will take part in transforming the needs of users and customers into a design of the final solution's user interface.

You will be working with one or more of our applications, web and/or internet and mobile solutions where you will be dealing with domain knowledge and interaction design. You will be working with the following type of tasks:

- Analysing, sketching and prototyping
- Drawing up of low fidelity paper prototypes and high fidelity interactive prototypes
- Defining solution design with interaction and navigation principles
- Creating information design and information architecture
- Performing usability test and quality assurance
- Collaborating with customers and software developers in making a design in scope of the budget and the technical platform
- Planning, executing and evaluating field studies
- Drawing up of user profiles and user scenarios
- Arranging, facilitating and analysing workshops grounded in User Centered Design (Human-Computer Interaction)
