



SU during study abroad



Can I receive SU while I am abroad?

- › Enrolled in an institution of higher education
- › You are less than 12 months behind schedule in your study program
- › You still have SU left
- › If you are not a Danish citizen you still have to meet the requirements regarding your equality e.g. work 10-12 hours per week in Denmark
 - › Resided in Denmark for at least 5 years

Address while you are abroad

- › The amount of your SU grant is dependent on your registered address on the 1st of any month.
- › If your registered address in DK is the same as your parents OR If your registered address is abroad you will receive SU according to "hjemmeboende"
- › In order to receive SU as "udeboende" you need to inform the SU system via minSU that you are temporarily abroad and not staying with your parents.

Transfer of credits

- › Send confirmation of enrollment or contract of internship with your preapproval of credit transfer to the SU-office before going abroad.
- › Make sure you inform your study centre of your completed study abroad or internship.

Paid internships

- › If you receive any salary for your internship you cannot receive SU for this period of time
- › However, your place of work is allowed to contribute to your documented expenses e.g. transportation or telephone
- › You have the possibility to apply for an advancement of SU prior to starting your internship to cover the gap between receiving your first salary and your last SU payment.

Check list

- › Make sure your expected date of completion is correct in minSU
- › Send relevant documentation to the SU-office in Aarhus su@au.dk
- › Make sure that your address is registered according to the rules
- › Check your financial statements on e-boks
- › Apply for credit transfer upon your return
