How can we help?

- **Advising**
 - For all students who want to study in the U.S.
 - Questions on internships in the U.S.
- **Grants**
 - Students (graduate-level only, Danish citizens)
 - Researchers (Danish citizens)
 - Scholars (Danish citizens)



Use our services

- Book an individual advising session
 - Come by our office and talk to an advisor
- Book a seat at one of our info meetings
 - We arrange several info meetings year-round
- Send us an email or call our advising center



The Money Winning Application

- There are no shortcuts
- Thoroughness, honesty, personality and of course skills
- Make sure to give an impression of who you are
- Make sure to be remembered
- Simple – clear
- You ARE good (grades, recommendations etc.)
- You show that you are good (CV, personal statement)



The Money Winning Application

- Explain what you are seeking funds for
- Keep it simple – “short and sweet”
- Explain why you are going abroad/why the country
- Coherence between what you say and what your recommendations say
- Your entire application needs to be coherent

The Money Winning Application

Formalities

- You have all the “facts” right and have researched the particular grant
 - Only apply for grants suitable for you (purpose and profile)
 - Grant/foundation name, address etc.
- Hand in application on time – make sure to meet the deadline!
- The application should look “nice”
- Politeness towards secretariat, board etc.

Application Overview

- **Start early**
- **Go through “Legathåndbogen” and other available sources**
- **Make a list:**
 - Which grants do you qualify for?
 - What is your purpose?
 - Can you apply before/after you have been accepted?
 - Should you apply before/after leaving Denmark?
 - When/how should you apply etc.?
- **Write grant applications**
- **Send your applications**



Fulbright Grants



Fulbright – DKK 50,000-85,000

- Minimum one semester
- You have to pay tuition (this might differ for Ph.D.-students)
- You need to have Danish citizenship
- Master and Ph.D.



Fulbright Joint Grants



Entire/partly 'tuition reduction' + 85,000 kr.

Min. one academic year

- Columbia University, GSAS
- New York University, GSAS
- The University of Chicago, Division of the Physical Sciences
- University of Pittsburgh, Graduate School of Public and International Affairs
