BA Project - Green Cultural Studies  
The students reported that high rates of preparation, in-class participation, and an in-class environment that promoted learning. In the words of one student, "It was so interesting! And the class discussions were always great, lively and interesting. I feel like I've learned a lot from this course, and that it has changed the way I interpret the world around me."

3<sup>rd</sup> Semester BA elective Pop Art:  
The students rated the course as highly relevant with importance for their studies, the alignment of the teaching with the course goals (for the exam), and the clear communication of ideas. In the words of one student, "When we were openly invited to discuss subject matter and ask questions in class and be given good answers by [the teacher]. X is a good, motivating and lively teacher and inspires enthusiasm."

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Evaluating Evidence (MA): A representative comment from one of the students summed up the general assessment of this course, which was being taught for the first time: "The diversity of the classes, and group work at a higher academic level. All great learning experiences."
