PLANNING EXCHANGE - HA/BSC STUDENTS

When?

Apply on the 3rd semester to go on exchange on the 5th semester

ECTS:

Be able to credit transfer 20-30 ECTS from your study abroad to your AU degree programme

Mandatory and elective courses:

Finance 10 ECTS

Operations Management
10 FCTS

Electives 10 ECTS

PREAPPROVAL OF COURSES

- Preapproval of host university courses with your AU study board is your guarantee of credit transfer to your AU degree programme
- Application for preapproval of courses is submitted via mystudies.au.dk <u>AFTER</u> you have been allocated an exchange position and have access to the course offer at your host university
- Find information about preapproval and the list of previously assessed courses on your <u>BTECH study portal</u>

Preapproval and credit transfer

You can apply for an external course to replace a course in your study programme. We call this a preapproval (before you leave) or a credit transfer (after you have completed the course). It is up to the Board of Studies to decide whether the course get a preapproval or a credit transfer. The course must be at a sufficient level and be relevant for your education.

Step 1: Apply for preapproval

Step 2:: Apply for admission to the course, you have to apply at the university/education which offers the course.

Step 3: Apply for credit tranfer, when you have passed the course.

SPECIAL EDUCATION SUPPORT

- Special Education Support (SPS) is also available for students going on exchange
- The same support as you receive during a semester in Denmark
- Support is for students with dyslexia, psychological and neurological disorders, and other disabilities and illnesses

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ERASMUS+ AGREEMENTS AND BILATERAL AGREEMENTS

ERASMUS+ AGREEMENTS

- No tuition fees
- Eligible for Erasmus+ grant of approx.
 Euro 470-500 per month
- Standard letter to document English language skills. Check MoveON to see if an English language test is required
- Includes countries in the EU + a few more

BILATERAL (OVERSEAS) AGREEMENTS

- No tuition fees
- BSS Travel Grant of DKK 7,000
- Standard letter to document English language skills. Check MoveON to see if an English language test is required
- Overseas countries incl. UK







FREEMOVER

- You arrange the stay yourself. Start early!
- You must pay tuition fee (if any) to the host university
- You are not eligible for Erasmus+ grant or BSS Travel Grant
- Udlandsstipendium. Apply through SU if you are eligible for SU
- Different private agents
- Apply for preapproval through your AU study board via mystudies.au.dk.

Udlandsstipendiet

The Danish state scholarship arrangement



Through this arrangement students with the right to Danish SU can receive a grant to pay tuation fees abroad. The scholarship called "udlandsstipendiet" is only for students who do **not** travel abroad via one of AU's exchange agreements, as you never have to pay tuition fees yourself if you go on exchange via AU's agreements.

It is important to be aware that in most cases the scholarship only covers part of the tuition fee, and that you must finance the difference yourself either with your own funds or via the State Educational Loan, which you can read more about below. The scholarship and loan cannot be used for expenses other than the tuition fee.

Below you can read more about the two types of stays abroad for which you can apply for a scholarship. The two types are not mutually exclusive, but overall you can receive a scholarship equivalent to 120 ECTS or two years of study at most.

Please note that it is not possible to apply for this scholarship for an entire bachelor's degree abroad.



- Short-term stays 2-8 weeks








IN THE MOVEON DATABASEN YOU CAN FIND...

STEP 2: CHECK THE COURSE OFFER AT THE PARTNER UNIVERSITIES



COURSE SELECTION IN YOUR APPLICATION

In the online application you will be asked to write course selection at the host university. This is to ensure that you only apply for universities that offer courses which are relevant to your study programme and which you find interesting

Finding relevant courses – also for your 5the semester mandatory courses - is your responsibility!!

Be aware of course restriction for exchange students at the host university

- You are welcome to list courses from the <u>list of previously assessed courses</u> in the form
- Do not submit course descriptions
- This is **NOT** an application for pre-approval of courses!
- No guarantee that previously approved courses will be offered/approved again!
- The course selection from is not binding. Your host university will later ask you to apply for courses





LIST OF PREVIOUSLY ASSESSED COURSES

To get an idea about which electives other HA/BSc students have studied at a specific university, search the <u>list of previously assessed courses</u> which can be found on your BTECH study portal:




HOW TO APPLY VIA MOVEON 1/3




HOW TO APPLY VIA MOVEON 2/3








HOW TO APPLY VIA MOVEON 3/3


PRIORITY (1)

IMPORTANT! You have to select the same degree programme for all your priorities











JOINT APPLICATION

In your online application you may choose "joint application", if you and a fellow student from the same degree programme wish to go abroad to the same host university.

- You and your fellow applicant must submit individual application but with the exact same list of priorities - otherwise you application will be rejected!
- You will be allocated exchange position according to the applicant with the lowest GPA
- AU cannot guarantee exchange at the same host university
- If joint allocation is not possible, your will NOT be allocated an exchange position individually, but will have to reapply in the 2nd application round in February







HOW WE ALLOCATE EXCHANGE POSITIONS

- According to highest Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Your GPA consists of a weighted average of all grades obtained at AU (both from your current study programme and from previously completed study programme) as of early December 2024.
- Grades from non-completed study programmes at AU are not included unless credit transferred with a grade to your current study programme
- It is not possible to say which GPA you need for a specific university as the GPA changes every year

If you must meet a specific GPA requirement at the time of applying to AU, you must also be able to meet this requirement at the time of applying to the host university!





APPLICATION DEADLINE

Exchange in autumn 2025: 2 December 2024 at 23:59

If your application is rejected, you can reapply during the "2nd application round" in February 2025

Be aware that the 2nd application round will only consist of exchange positions which was not allocated during the 1st application round



MID-JANUARY YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED THAT.....

...You have been allocated an exchange position ©

- You will be asked to accept the exchange position <u>you will only receive one offer</u>, so make sure
 your have prioritized correctly. You cannot change the order.
- You cannot be allocated a new exchange position
- You cannot swap your exchange position with a fellow student

...You have not been allocated an exchange position \otimes

- Apply for a leftover position in the 2nd application round
- 2nd application round: Early February (time + date to be announced on your Study Portal)

OCTOBER 2024

 2nd application round: Only if you were not allocated a position in the 1st application round or you forgot to apply
