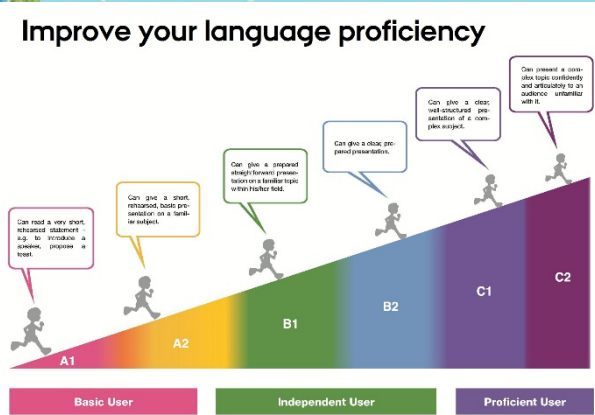

ECTS:

Be able to credit transfer 20-30 ECTS from your study abroad to your AU degree programme

WHEN CAN YOU STUDY ABROAD?

- Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Economics and Business Administration: 5th semester
- Master of Science (MSc) in Economics and Business Administration (Cand.merc): 3rd semester
- Master of Science (MSc) in Economics (Cand.oecon): 3rd semester (or 1st or 2nd semester)
- Master of Science (MSc) in Economics – (Cand.oecon - Public Policy): 3rd semester (or 1st semester)

WHO CAN APPLY



In order to apply for exchange studies you must:

- Be a full time student at AU
- Be able to **transfer 20 ECTS to 30 ECTS** from your studies abroad to you AU study programme (pay extra attention if you have been granted start credit transfer from previous studies or taken summer university courses)
- If you apply for master level studies, you have to be enrolled in a master level programme at AU by the time you commence your studies abroad
- You cannot apply for an exchange on your master's programme while studying a bachelor's programme if you plan to take a break between your bachelor's and master's studies
- If you have been allocated an exchange place and then take a break between your bachelor's and master's studies, you will lose your exchange place.

EXCHANGE – DURING SEMESTER W/ELECTIVES

You are expected to take **30 ECTS** during your study abroad*

*At some universities you will only be able to take 20 ECTS (check MoveON)

*At some universities it may be difficult to take more than 20 ECTS (check MoveON)

*Some students might fail one or more courses during their study abroad

If you transfer only 20 ECTS or 25 ECTS from your study abroad you can:

- Take courses at AU Summer University (before or after your exchange semester)
- Take additional courses the following semester upon your return

Some universities require students to take 25-30 ECTS in which case you must do so even though you may only be able to transfer 20 ECTS to your AU study programme

PREAPPROVAL OF COURSES

- **Preapproval of host university courses** with your AU study board is your guarantee of credit transfer to your AU degree programme
- Application for preapproval of courses is submitted via mystudies.au.dk **AFTER** you have been allocated an exchange position and have access to the course offer at your host university
- Find information about preapproval and the list of previously assessed courses on your study portal

Preapproval and credit transfer

You can apply for an external course to replace a course in your study programme. We call this a preapproval (before you leave) or a credit transfer (after you have completed the course). It is up to the Board of Studies to decide whether the course get a preapproval or a credit transfer. The course must be at a sufficient level and be relevant for your education.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ERASMUS+ AGREEMENTS AND BILATERAL AGREEMENTS

ERASMUS+ AGREEMENTS

- No tuition fees
- Eligible for Erasmus+ grant of approx. Euro 470-500 per month
- Standard letter to document English language skills. Check MoveON to see if an English language test is required
- Includes countries in the EU + a few more

BILATERAL (OVERSEAS) AGREEMENTS

- No tuition fees
- BSS Travel Grant of DKK 7,000
- Standard letter to document English language skills. Check MoveON to see if an English language test is required
- Overseas countries incl. UK

FREEMOVER

- You arrange the stay yourself. Start early!
- You must pay tuition fee (if any) to the host university
- You are not eligible for Erasmus+ grant or BSS Travel Grant
- Udlandsstipendium. Apply through SU if you are eligible for SU
- Different private agents
- Apply for preapproval through your AU study board via mystudies.au.dk.

Udlandsstipendiet

The Danish state scholarship arrangement

Through this arrangement students with the right to Danish SU can receive a grant to pay tuition fees abroad. The scholarship called "udlandsstipendiet" is only for students who do **not** travel abroad via one of AU's exchange agreements, as you never have to pay tuition fees yourself if you go on exchange via AU's agreements.

It is important to be aware that in most cases the scholarship only covers part of the tuition fee, and that you must finance the difference yourself either with your own funds or via the State Educational Loan, which you can read more about below. The scholarship and loan cannot be used for expenses other than the tuition fee.

Below you can read more about the two types of stays abroad for which you can apply for a scholarship. The two types are not mutually exclusive, but overall you can receive a scholarship equivalent to 120 ECTS or two years of study at most.

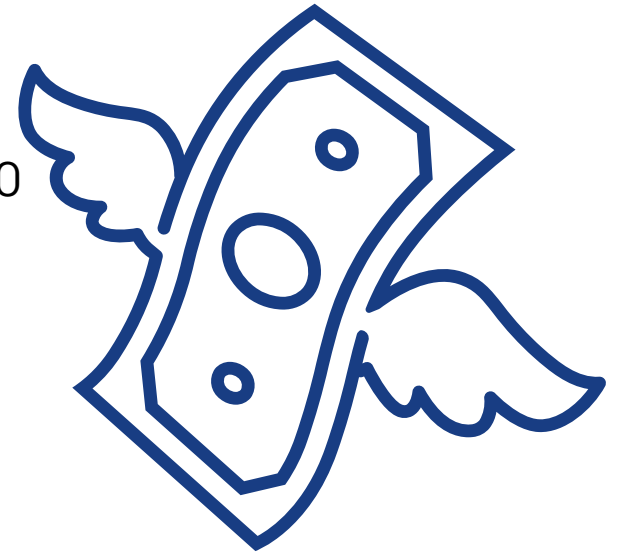
Please note that it is not possible to apply for this scholarship for an entire bachelor's degree abroad.

SUMMER SCHOOL

- Short-term stays - 2-8 weeks





Finding relevant courses is your responsibility.

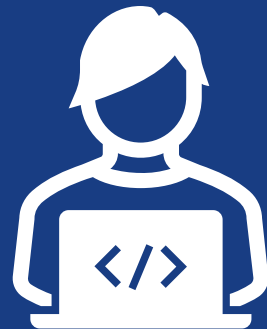

JOINT APPLICATION

In your online application you may choose "joint application", if you and a fellow student from the same degree programme wish to go abroad to the same host university.

- You and your fellow applicant must submit individual application but with the exact same list of priorities – [otherwise your application will be rejected!](#)
- You will be allocated exchange position according to the applicant with the lowest GPA
- AU cannot guarantee exchange at the same host university
- If joint allocation is not possible, you will NOT be allocated an exchange position individually, but will have to reapply in the 2nd application round in February



HOW MANY PRIORITIES?

Feel free to choose multiple priorities – a maximum of 20 priorities

BUT only select priorities in which you are genuinely interested.

If you decline your spot or cancel your stay, the spot cannot be transferred to one of your fellow students, and the spot cannot be applied for in later rounds.

- **Transcript of Records:** Only upload if you have not received any grades from Aarhus University at the time of application—for example, if you are a new master's student who completed your bachelor's degree at another institution. For everyone else, the GPA will be retrieved automatically.



HOW WE ALLOCATE EXCHANGE POSITIONS

- According to highest Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Your GPA consists of a weighted average of all grades obtained at AU (both from your current study programme and from previously completed study programme) as of early December 2024.
- Grades from non-completed study programmes at AU are not included unless credit transferred with a grade to your current study programme
- It is not possible to say which GPA you need for a specific university as the GPA changes every year

If you must meet a specific GPA requirement at the time of applying to AU, you must also be able to meet this requirement at the time of applying to the host university!

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Exchange in autumn 2025: **2 December 2024 at 23:59**

If your application is rejected, you can reapply during the "2nd application round" **in February 2025**

Be aware that the 2nd application round will only consist of exchange positions which were not allocated during the 1st application round

MID-JANUARY YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED THAT.....

...You have been allocated an exchange position 😊

- You will be asked to accept the exchange position – **you will only receive one offer**, so make sure you have prioritized correctly. You cannot change the order.
- You cannot be allocated a new exchange position
- You cannot swap your exchange position with a fellow student

...You have not been allocated an exchange position 😞

- Apply for a leftover position in the 2nd application round
- 2nd application round: Early February (time + date to be announced on your Study Portal)
- 2nd application round: Only if you were not allocated a position in the 1st application round or you forgot to apply
