



#### Course content

The availability of big data has the potential to reshape the business landscape leading to unprecedented opportunities. However, organizations have recently become aware of the 'last mile problem': in this new world, few are actually making decisions based on the available data. This is because traditionally managers have limited understanding of analytics, while data scientists have limited knowledge of business outcomes (Berinato 2019).

This course aims to provide students with knowledge and practice with core methods and tools used in big data analytics, from a business perspective. The goal is to provide them with first hand experience with these tools and thereafter facilitate discussions on business uses and managerial implications

The course will focus on the R language and R Studio environment, but the students will gain exposure and some practice with other solutions (such as Python, SQL etc)

#### Step-by-step guide to registration



- Please find the elective courses offered on your degree programme in the AU course catalogue.
   You can limit your search by selecting "degree programme" and "period".
- 2. Please select which courses you wish to register for. Your registration is binding. This means that you will not be able to cancel or change your registration for elective courses once the deadline for registration has expired, unless you apply for and are granted a dispensation from the board of studies.
- 3. Please log on to <u>mystudies.au.dk</u> find a direct link to the student self-service system (STADS) register for courses. Go to -> 'Courses' -> 'Register'. Here you will find a registration form with a list of your course options.







# BUT REMEMBER, REGISTRATION IS BINDING...

You cannot <u>deregister or change</u> your electives after the deadline has passed the 5<sup>th</sup> of May 2024!

#### Cancelling elective courses



All students who have been registered for their selected courses are bound by their choice. This means that you will not be able to cancel or change your registration for elective courses once the deadline for registration has expired, and the elective course is a binding part of your study programme.
