Instructions for submitting as a group in Digital Exam

This is a guide to how you form a group in Digital Exam. The guide contains the following:

- Group formation <u>before</u> the start of the exam
- Group formation <u>after</u> the start of the exam
- Deadline for group formation
- Acceptance of a group invitation
- Submitting only one assignment

Group formation before the start of the exam

If it is possible to form a group before the start of the exam, it will be stated when you enter Digital Exam:

Acceptance of a group invitation

When you form a group in Digital Exam, all invited group members must accept the invitation. If a fellow student has sent you a group invitation, it will be visible for you when you click on the exam:

Click 'Accept' if you wish to accept the group invitation. It is important that all group members accept the invitation before you hand in your assignment to make sure all group members receive a receipt by mail.

Submitting only one assignment

When you submit an assignment as a group in Digital Exam, only one of the group members must upload and submit the assignment and any appendices. The remaining group members shall simply make sure that the group invitation is accepted so that they are formally part of the group.
