

## Documentation requirements for exemptions in connection with COVID-19

Reason for application	Documentation requirements
Not possible to continue laboratory work, etc. (e.g. completion of BA/BA of Engineering project/Master's thesis)	Statement from the supervisor, which relates to the need for postponement, the necessary resources during the extension period, including supervision of the student.
Participation in the emergency response (handling critical social functions in connection with the COVID-19 situation).	Confirmation from workplace, and if not possible; a solemn declaration.
Care of children sent home from institution and primary- and lower secondary school (e.g. deregistration of future exams, postponement of deadlines for submission)	Solemn declaration
Illness in which you need to document illness here and now, e.g. when withdrawing from exams where you need to document illness on the day of the exam	A doctor's certificate, and if not possible; a solemn declaration.
Long-term illness In case of long-term illness, follow the usual rules for exemptions at Nat and Tech	A doctor's certificate. It can be necessary to postpone the procedure until a doctor's certificate is obtained.

If you, for example, are affected by both a lack of access to the lab and care for your own children at home, you need to document both.
