### **Stamhold**

Er du en af de studerende, skal du holde en meters afstand, og der vil derfor være særlige zoner i auditorierne, hvor der er afstand nok. De fleste førsteårsstuderende kommer på stamhold ved studiestart bortset fra diplomingeniørstuderende. Hvis der er andre hold, der bliver en gjort til et stamhold, bliver de informeret via instituttet eller deres underviser.

### **En meters krav**

For langt de fleste studerende vil der være krav om at holde en meters afstand, når du er til undervisning, og når du færdes på AU. I lokalerne vil der være anvisninger til, hvordan du skal placere dig, så afstandskravet overholdes.

### **Forsamlingsforbud**

Hvis I planlægger at holde sociale arrangementer med mange deltagere, så vær opmærksom på, at forsamlingsforbuddet på flere end 100 personer ved arrangementer er forlænget.

Dear students,

A new semester lies before us – one that will unfortunately be affected by the Corona situation. We have planned for as much as possible of the teaching to take place on campus, so you can get back to a normal everyday routine at Aarhus University. However, there will still be teaching, which will be conducted online moving forward. Moreover, we will do everything we can to ensure safety and security on Aarhus University.

### **Fixed study teams**

For most first year students and some second year students, fixed study teams will be formed (this does not apply to the Bachelor of Engineering programme/*diplomingeniør*). If you have been assigned to a fixed study team, you will only attend teaching with your own team and therefore, the distance requirement of 1 meter need not be observed. In these teams, there may be a few students attending the course with other teams because they are attending the course as part of the available student place scheme, have been granted credit transfer, are supplementary subject students or the like. If any of these categories apply to you, you need to observe the distance requirement of 1 meter, and there will subsequently be special zones in all lecture theatres with sufficient distance. Most first year students, aside from the Bachelor of Engineering students, will be sorted into fixed study teams at the start of your studies. If other students are assigned to a fixed study team, they will be informed via the institute or their teacher.

### **The distance requirement of 1 meter**

For the vast majority of students, the distance requirement of 1 meter must be observed when you are attending classes or lectures and when you move about campus. In the teaching rooms, directions on how to station yourself while maintaining a safe distance will be available.

### **Ban on gatherings**

If you plan on gathering for social events with many participants, please be aware that the ban on gathering more than 100 people at events has been extended.
