Information om håndtering undervisning og eksamen i forbindelse med Corona-krisen

Den fysiske nedlukning af Aarhus Universitet afføder en lang række spørgsmål knyttet til undervisning, eksamen, udlandsophold, praktik mv. Omlægning af undervisning til andre formater

For at sikre undervisningen har Aarhus Universitet styrket og suppleret den digitale infrastruktur for læring. Derigennem er der skabt mulighed for at omlægge undervisningen til andre formater. Vi beder om, at du løbende holder dig opdateret i dine kursusrum i Blackboard. Her vil din underviser kommunikere, hvordan undervisningen vil blive omlagt de kommende uger. Aarhus Universitet har ikke tidligere afprøvet teknologien i så stor en skala. Vi beder derfor om jeres tålmodighed, hvis ikke alt fungerer optimalt.

Vi vil så vidt muligt sikre at aflyst obligatorisk undervisning tilbydes senere eller konverteres til anden undervisning, ligesom det er muligt, at undervisning med tilstedeværelsespligt afløses af fjernundervisning med efterfølgende eksamen.

Der er mulighed for, at vi ændrer eksamensformer fra skriftlige eller mundtlige eksamener på Aarhus Universitet til hjemmeopgaver, distanceeksamen via fx Skype, eller ved at vi udskyder eksamen til et senere tidspunkt, som er fornuftigt i forhold til kommende undervisningsplaner. Efterhånden som der for det enkelte kursus sker en afklaring af forhold om eksamen, vil der blive informeret om det via kursusrummet i Blackboard.”

1. årsprøve, studietidsforlængelser mv.

Hvis du som følge af corona-situationen får brug for en eller flere undtagelser fra de regler, der gælder på din uddannelse, vil det kræve en individuel dispensation. I behandlingen af din ansøgning vil corona-situationen naturligvis blive set som et usædvanligt forhold, der tillægges stor vægt i den samlede vurdering af din ansøgning. Alle, der søger om dispensation, modtager en selvstændig afgørelse baseret på deres konkrete sagsforløb.

Information on handling teaching and exams in relation to the Corona crisis

The physical shutdown of Aarhus University raises a wide range of questions related to teaching, exams, stays abroad, internships, etc. An information site, where you can find answers to your questions, has therefore been set up. Click [here](#) to go to the site. Questions and answers will be updated on an ongoing basis. On the site, you will also find a chat feature where you can ask supplementary questions.

Reorganisation of teaching to other formats

In order to ensure teaching, Aarhus University has strengthened and complemented the digital infrastructure for learning. This has created the opportunity to convert teaching to other formats. We ask that you continuously keep yourself up to date in your Blackboard course rooms. Here, your teacher will communicate how the teaching will be rescheduled in the coming weeks. Aarhus University has not previously tested the technology on such a large scale. We therefore ask for your patience if not everything works optimally.

We will ensure, as far as possible, that cancelled compulsory teaching is offered later or is converted into other forms of teaching, just as it is possible that teaching with a duty of attendance will be replaced by distance learning online with subsequent examination.

There is the possibility that we change exam forms from written or oral exams at Aarhus University to homework assignments, distance exams via e.g. Skype, or by postponing the exam to a later date, which is reasonable in relation to future curricula. When the conditions related to exams on the individual programme are clarified, they will be communicated via the Blackboard course room.

First-year examination, study duration extension, etc.

If, as a result of the Corona situation, you will need one or more exceptions to the rules that apply to your programme, it will require an individual exemption. In the processing of your application, the Corona situation will of course be viewed as an unusual circumstance, which is given great weight in the overall assessment of your application. Anyone applying for an exemption receives an independent decision based on his or her specific case history.
