Academic calendar	<p>The academic year is split into Teaching Period 1 (first six months of the year) and Teaching Period 2 (second six months of the year). Each Teaching Period holds the main 13-week study period as well as block/intensive study periods.</p> <p>Semester one: Beginning February – end June Semester two: Mid July – mid December https://www.jcu.edu.au/students/important-dates</p>
Full academic program	<p>Undergraduate level: An undergraduate degree is three years of studies. Students must complete 72 credit points to graduate. A normal full work load is 24 credit points per academic year.</p> <p>Postgraduate level: The requirements of master degree programmes are fulfilled within 1½ and 36 credit points or 2 years and 48 credit points.</p> <p>There is no distinction between undergraduate and postgraduate full-time loads.</p>
