Full academic programme	<p>Undergraduate level: The period of study for a degree of Bachelor of Science is four academic years and typically 160 credits in total.</p> <p>In order to complete the degree requirements within the normal specified period of candidature, students are expected to carry an academic load of 20 credits per semester. A full course load per semester is 20 AU credits.</p> <p>Graduate level: The period of study for a degree of Master of Science is typically one academic year and 40 AU credits in total.</p> <p>In order to complete the degree requirements within the normal specified period of candidature, students are expected to carry an academic load of 20 credits per semester. A full course load per semester is 20 AU credits.</p>

Course level	<p>Each module of study has a unique module code consisting of a two- or three-letter prefix that denotes the discipline, and four digits, the first of which indicates the level of the module (e.g., 1000 indicates a Level 1 module and 2000, a Level 2 module).</p> <p>Undergraduate courses: 1000-4000 Graduate courses: 5000</p>
Recommendation	<p>20 credits will be transferred with 30 ECTS.</p> <p>It is possible to combine courses from undergraduate level and graduate level.</p>
ECTS equivalency	<p>Undergraduate level: 20 credits = 30 ECTS credits</p> <p>Graduate level: 20 credits = 30 ECTS credits</p>
