Academic calendar	<p>Temple University follows a semester system with the fall and spring semesters consisting of approximately 16 weeks, which includes one week for exams and one week per semester for a fall and spring break.</p> <p>Fall semester: Early September – Late December Spring semester: Mid-January – Early May</p> <p>http://www.temple.edu/registrar/documents/calendars/</p>
Full academic program	<p>Undergraduate level: An undergraduate degree is typically 4 years and 123 credits. An academic year is 2 semesters. The average full academic workload per semester is 15-16 credits</p> <p>Graduate level: A graduate degree includes the completion of 30 credit hours. Full academic workload per semester is 12 credit hours.</p>

Course level	<p>The first digit of a course code identifies its level.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Courses numbered 2000 - 2999 are appropriate for undergraduate students in their second year of study. • Courses numbered 3000 - 3999 are appropriate for undergraduate students in their third year of study. • Courses numbered 4000 - 4999 are appropriate for undergraduate students in their fourth year of study. • Courses numbered 5000 - 5999 are primarily for graduate students, but undergraduate students in their third or fourth year may enroll with permission of their instructors and the dean's designee. • Courses numbered 8000 - 9999 are for graduate students. <p>http://renumbering.temple.edu/conventions.htm</p>
Recommendation	<p>It is possible to combine courses from undergraduate level and graduate level.</p> <p>Undergraduate level: 4 courses per semester if 4 credit hours 5 courses per semester if 3 credit hours</p> <p>Graduate Level: 4 graduate courses of 3 credits per term will be transferred with 30 ECTS.</p>
ECTS equivalency	<p>Undergraduate level: 15 credits = 30 ECTS 3 credits = 6 ECTS</p> <p>Graduate level: 12 credits = 30 ECTS 3 credits = 7,5 ECTS</p>
