Full academic programme	<p>Undergraduate level: A bachelor's programme will consist of 120 points per academic year. A three-year degree involves 360 points of study, while a four-year degree involves 480 points.</p> <p>Graduate level: A master's degree will consist of 120 points per academic year. Duration is usually two semesters of full-time study.</p> <p>Both levels: The standard course load for is 50-60 points per semester or 100-120 points per year. Most courses are weighted 15 points and students generally take four courses per semester.</p>

Course level	<p>Courses are listed under their subject area For example, the course 'POPLHLTH 202—Research Methods in Health' is within a subject called 'Population Health' The numbers refer to the level.</p>
Recommendation	60 points or 4 courses of 15 points will be transferred with 30 ECTS.
ECTS equivalency	<p>60 points = 30 ECTS 15 points = 7,5 ECTS 2 points = 1 ECTS</p>
