Full academic programme	Undergraduate level The bachelor programmes are typically four-year programmes, and students must complete 180 units for graduation, i.e. 45 units per year or 15 units per term. UCLA is a full-time institution, and it is expected that students complete their undergraduate degree requirements promptly. Normal progress toward graduation in four years is defined as the completion of 45 units per year, or 15 units per term. Graduate level Three courses (or 12 units) per term are considered the normal enrollment for graduate students.
