Full academic program	Undergraduate level: Students must complete 180 credits to achieve a BSc degree for a total of 4 years. 45 credit hours per academic year are regarded as constituting a full workload for a student, which corresponds to 15 credits per term (three terms per year). Full workload per term is 15 credits or 22,5 credits per half year. Graduate level: To earn a master's degree, students must complete no fewer than 45 graduate credits in total. Each department sets its own minimum degree requirements (duration and number of credit units) equal to or beyond the minimum required by the Graduate School. Normal workload per term is 9 credit units or 13,5 credits per half year.

Course level	Course credit hour data are organized by course level, which correspond to the course numbering system. Undergraduate Course: Includes Lower Division Course and Upper Division Course from the course level detail report, or all courses numbered 100 to 400. Graduate Course: Courses numbered 500 and higher.
Recommendation	It is possible to combine courses from undergraduate level and graduate level. Undergraduate level: 15 credit units will be transferred with 20 ECTS. 22 credit units will be transferred with 30 ECTS. 45 credit units will be transferred with 60 ECTS. Graduate level 9 credit units will be transferred with 18 ECTS. 15 credit units will be transferred with 30 ECTS. 30 credit units will be transferred with 60 ECTS.
ECTS equivalency	Undergraduate: 3 credit units = 4 ECTS Graduate: 3 credit units = 6 ECTS
