Academic calendar	The academic year at UTS is divided into two main semesters, each with 14 weeks of teaching: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• February semester (Autumn) from February to June</li> <li>• July semester (Spring) from July to November</li> </ul>
Full academic program	<p><b>Undergraduate level:</b> Bachelor's degrees are 3 years (without honours).</p> <p>Students must complete a minimum of 144 credits during 3 years or 24 credits per semester. Most courses are worth 6 units of credit.</p> <p><b>Graduate level:</b> Master's degrees are typically 1,5 years (research) and 72 units of credit.</p> <p>A standard full workload is 24 points per semester.</p> <p>Most subjects at UTS are 6 credit points.</p>

Course level	<p><b>Information is ordered: Subject Number, Level, Name and Semester [February (F), July (J)]</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Level 1: Usually undertaken in first year (similar to 100 level, introductory level)</li> <li>• Level 2: Usually undertaken in second year (similar to 200 level, prior knowledge is required)</li> <li>• Level 3: Usually undertaken in third year (similar to 300 level, advanced level)</li> <li>• Subjects marked with an *(asterisk) have pre-requisites. You must provide evidence that you have passed a subject equivalent to the UTS pre requisite at your home institution.</li> </ul>
Recommendation	<p><b>Undergraduate and graduate level:</b> 4 courses (each 6 credits) per semester will be transferred with 30 ECTS.</p>
ECTS equivalency	<p><b>Undergraduate and graduate level:</b> 24 points = 30 ECTS 6 points = 7,5 ECTS 1 point = 1,25 ECTS</p>
