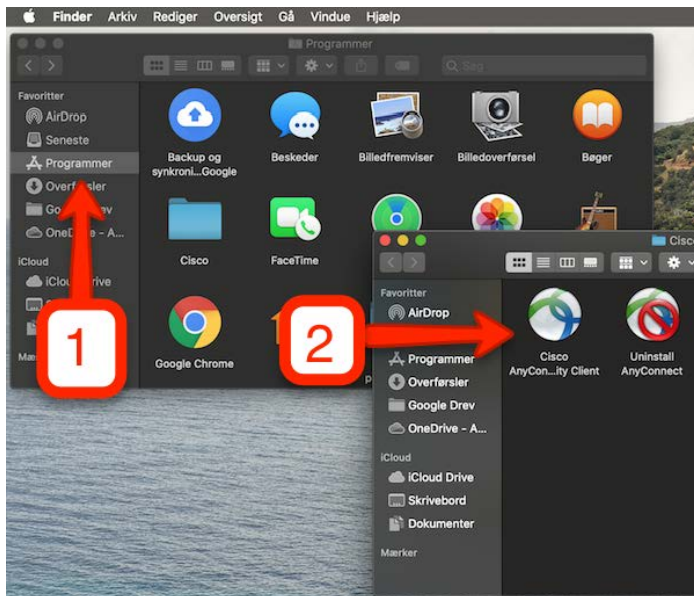


How to log on to VPN from your Mac OS

In order to log on to VPN, Cisco AnyConnect must be installed. If this is not the case, please follow the guide 'How to install the VPN client on a Mac OS'.

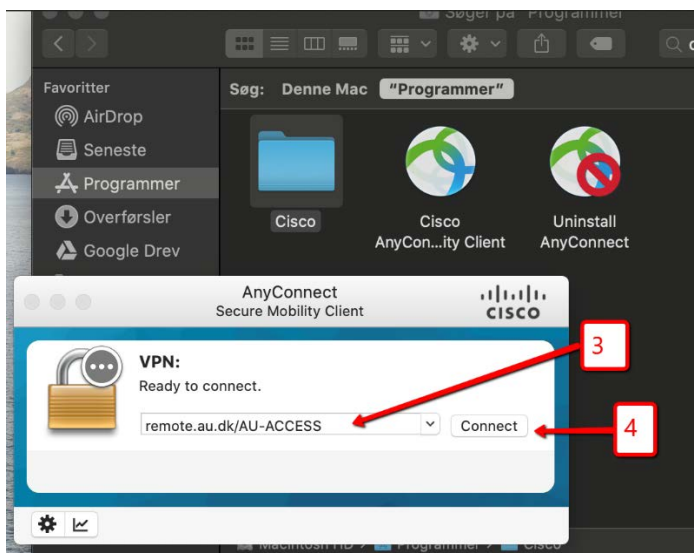
How to log on to VPN

1. Open the folder 'Programs'
2. Find the Cisco Anyconnect Client and double-click.

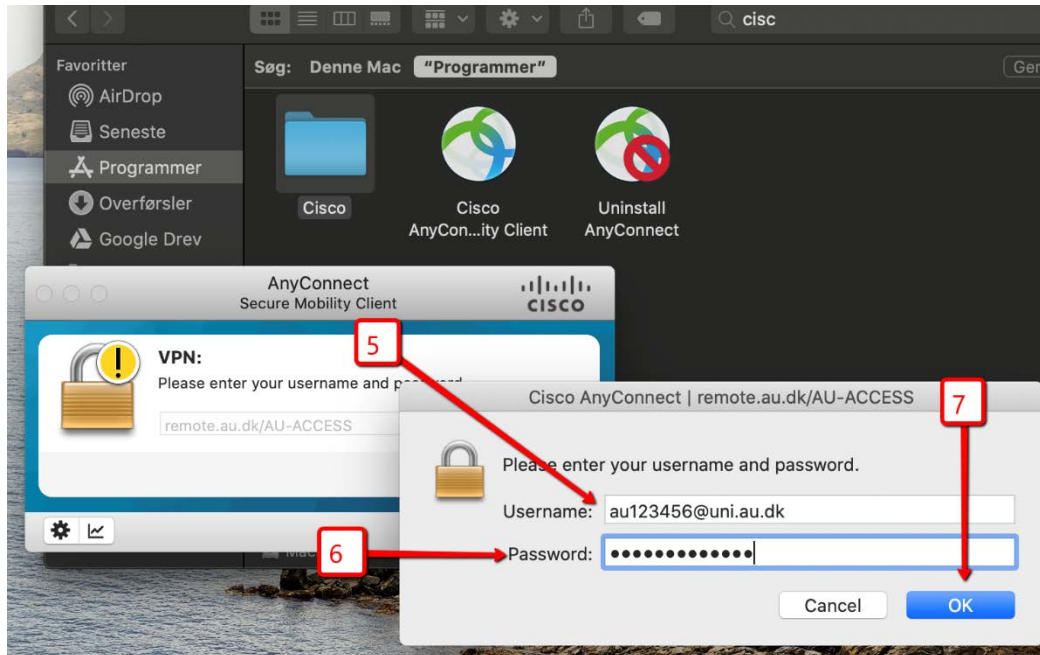


3. Write 'remote.au.dk/AU-ACCESS' in the field.

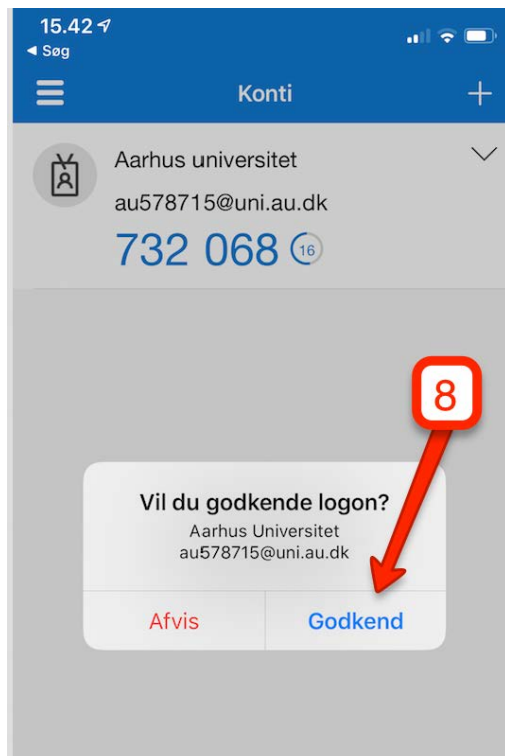
4. Click 'Connect'.



5. Enter your AU ID followed by '@uni.au.dk'.
6. Enter your password.
7. Click 'OK'.

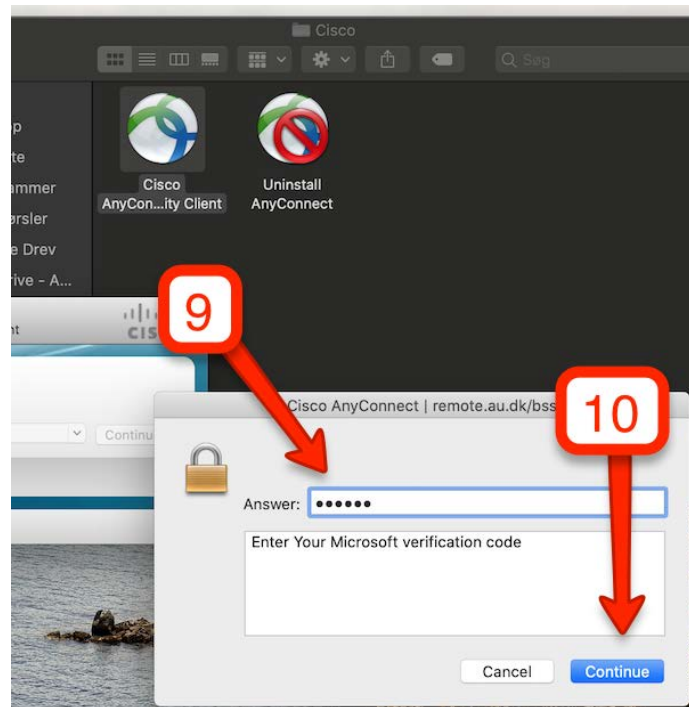
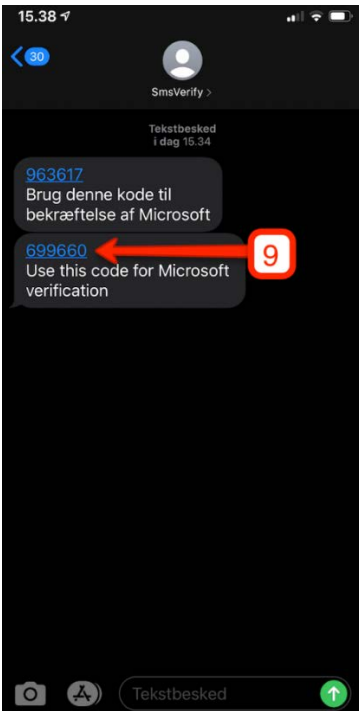


8. If two-step authentication is connected via the app, you will receive a notification which you must approve.



9. If two-step authentication is connected via SMS code, you will receive an SMS code on your mobile.

10. Enter the SMS code in the field and click 'Continue'.



11. If you can see a green checkmark on the padlock, you are connected to VPN.



12. On the status bar on the menu bar, you can disconnect by clicking 'Disconnect'.
